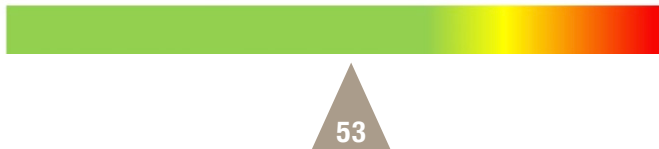

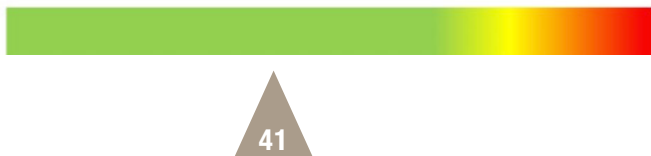


Our concise curriculum also lowers projected monthly payments compared to other programs, because your student loans spend less time accruing interest while you're still sitting in a classroom.

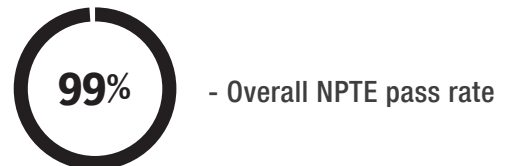
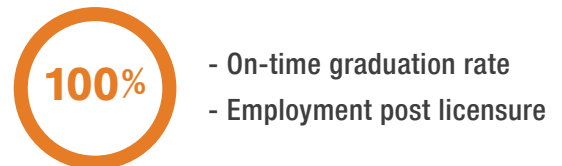
