

# BILINGUAL SPEECH LANGUAGE PATHOLOGIST GRADUATE STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

### **Purpose**

In order to promote more bilingual Spanish Speech-Language Pathologists to support the many Hispanic students in our community, Delta Education and Therapy Services is pleased to announce this scholarship opportunity for bilingual graduate students who are admitted to the master's degree Speech-Language Pathology program of the University of the Pacific in 2024.

## **Scholarship Details**

Three scholarships are slated to be awarded. Scholarship amounts will range from \$5,000 to \$10,000, with specific amounts to be determined by the scholarship committee depending on the applicant pool.

### **Eligibility Criteria**

The successful applicant will be:

- A licensed Speech-Language Pathology Assistant
- Fluent Bilingual Spanish speaker
- Accepted into and enrolled in the Speech-Language Pathology Program of the University of the Pacific for the master's program beginning in 2024.
- Preference will be given to applicants who are the first generation in their families to attend college.

### **Application Process**

- 1. Complete two written essays in English.
- A. The first essay will be focused on your background. Tell us about your journey to the field of speech-language pathology as well as your experience as an SLPA. If you are a first-generation person in your family to attend college, please include information about how that has influenced your academic career.
- B. The second essay will focus on your plans for your career as a Speech-Language Pathologist. Tell us how you will use your SLP license to support the Hispanic students in your community.
- 2. Demonstrate proficiency in Spanish via a Zoom meeting. The Zoom interview will take 4-5 minutes and will be held in February 2024. Please prepare a lesson for a student and present this lesson in Spanish for this interview.
